Commonly asked questions:

Can we bring our own wine/champagne?

We are fully licensed and have a fully stocked bar but yes, you can. We charge a per bottle opened corkage and try to keep the number of bottles opened to a minimum to save on wastage. Please contact us to get the current corkage fee. We are able to stock any particular alcohol you like, and our wine list showcases a great range of local wines.

Please note while we allow guests to bring in their own wine and bubbles (corkage applies) the rest of the bar must be run by White Water Farm. We do allow a keg to be set up which we are happy to organize for you. There is a "beerage" fee that is charged with all kegs. We do not allow any other spirits, beers or soft drinks to be brought in. If there is a specific drink you would like we are happy to quote and supply for you.

How does the catering work?

Bridal couple would need to organize caterers to do all the food. We have a list of caterers which we can supply on request. We do have a full kitchen for them to come in and use.

What is the cut-off time?

The package includes the use of the venue up to 24h00. Extensions are allowed and will be charged a per hour fee after 24h00.

Can I bring my own wedding cake?

You are more than welcome to bring your own wedding cake as a dessert. A plating charge of R15 per person will be added to your bill. Please advise us prior to the wedding of storage and plating requirements.

How does the bar work?

There are a number of ways to organize the operation of the bar on your wedding day.

Cash Bar: Your guests pay for their own beverages at the bar. We can run individual tabs for guests but please note any tabs not settled on the evening or by check out for guests staying on the farm will be automatically added to the bride and grooms bill.

Limited Tab: You select a monetary tab limit that you will pay towards the bar. Once the limit is reached then the bar changes over to a cash bar. If you choose to have a limited tab, then you will have the option to set a new limit on the evening.

Limited Drinks Tab: You can have a tab made for specific drinks only and all other drinks will be for guests own account.

Open Tab: Your guests may drink anything at the bar for the entire evening and the bride & groom settle the full tab before departure.

Do I have to use the tent?

Guests have to make use of the Bedouin tent. Indoor seating is only available for 30 people. If the wedding is 30 people or less please contact us for a reduced wedding package.

Does White Water provide a wedding planner?

The staff at White Water are there to make your day run as smoothly as possible. We are responsible for all of the services that we provide, but we are not wedding planners or coordinators. We have worked with many of our local suppliers and can recommend who to use.

This is to ensure you have the most beautiful and stress free wedding day.
